N: iv-3 set left margin so reviewer fits on a single line
T: 9-4-4 “an” should be “a”
C: 19-3-5 strike “non-chemical” (it is non-chemically determined)
C: 21-1-2 after “manufactured” add “for the simplest case (more complex cases covered later)”
C: 24-1-4 before “.” add “, each of which requires over 150 existing proteins”
T: 28-2-3 replace “the” with “there”
N: 41-3-4 replace both “and” with “or” and insert “by” before “A”
T: 43-5-1 “. The” should be “. There”
E: 50-4-7 replace “proteins” with “amino acids for proteins”
N: 51-4-5 after “,” add “the one making”
T: 54-1-4 add “s” to “scientist”
C: 56-4-7 replace “codon” with “nucleotide” (a codon has translation syntax)
E: 57-1-1 replace “50” with “1”
C: 63-3 delete paragraph and reword surrounding sentences to simplify
N: 67-2-5 after “certain” add “in”
N: 76 drop “s” from “Leads” in title
